Social Security Number


 While it is optional to enter your social security number, it is recommended to include it for financial aid purposes

Important Notes for Creating an Account

When creating an account there are a few helpful items to remember

These include:

- If you have an account that you used to apply for any semester before Summer 2022, please create a new account. Your old username and password will not work on this site.
- · Your email address is used to verify your account and to send you emails.
- · Be sure to check yout spam/junk folder for any emails from us.
- Please be aware that email verification is required. Some school districts block emails from outside organizations (including @applytexas.org). If you
 are not receiving emails from us this may be the reason and you should consider using another email address.
- Verification links expire in 24 hours. You must request a new one if this happens.
- · You can use either your username or your verified email address to log in to your account.


